Dr Tom Daly—Vascular and Endovascular Surgeon

Topic: The Vascular Surgeon and the Diabetic Foot

Dr Tom Daly graduated in 1995 from the University of Sydney and completed both a general and vascular surgical fellowship in 2003 and 2005 respectively. He also completed a DDU in vascular. Dr Daly is a senior lecturer at both the University of Sydney and the University of Western Sydney. He attends at Norwest Private Hospital as well as Westmead and Blacktown Hospitals. He has an interest in the endovascular management of aneurysms as well as venous and vascular ulcerations, including the diabetic foot. Dr Daly has publications in various aspects of vascular disease and is undertaking a clinical doctorate in surgery looking into endovascular aneurysm repair.

Topic: Management of the Diabetic Foot

Dr Mauro Vicaretti graduated in medicine from the University of Sydney in 1990 and received his General Surgical fellowship of the Royal Australasian College of Surgeons 1999 and Vascular Surgery fellowship of the Royal Australasian College of Surgeons 2001. He completed a PhD in Vascular Graft Infections in an Ovine Model (Usyd) in 2002. Dr Vicaretti is a vascular surgeon at Westmead, Auburn, Westmead Private and Norwest Private Hospitals. He is the Sub Dean at the Western Clinical School, Westmead Hospital and is member of Board of Vascular Surgery and a committee member of CHASM. He has extensive experience in the management of acute and chronic vascular disease with a particular interest in the diabetic foot. He has numerous publications in clinical and experimental vascular disease.

Dr Irwin Mohan—Vascular and Endovascular Surgeon

Topic: Vascular Ulcer Disease

Dr Irwin Mohan did his postgraduate vascular training in the UK and worked as a Consultant Vascular Surgeon at Manchester Royal Infirmary from 2001 to 2006. In 2006 he relocated to Australia. Since then he has worked at Westmead Hospital and at Norwest Private Hospital. He is also the Network Director for Surgical Training for Sydney West and Clinical Senior Lecturer with the University of Sydney. Dr Mohan continues to be an Examiner with the European Board of Vascular Surgery Qualifications, and also for the Royal Australasian College of Surgeons. Dr Mohan did research at the Imperial College, University of London for a Doctor of Medicine research degree (MD) into Peripheral arterial disease, homocysteine and platelet function. He serves as a reviewer for a number of International Medical Journals and has many publications in the field of Vascular and Endovascular Surgery.
